Shilton Parish Council Update:

Shilton Parish Council has recently received a progress update from Ecotricity. They have stated that in light of the concerns shown by residents i.e.

- Ladburn Lane and Hen N Chick Lane access
- Potential impact of construction traffic
- Safety issues

Ecotricity will explore the option of an alternative access point other than Ladburn Lane.

In the meantime the revised application will maintain the current point of access via

Ladburn Lane. However, prior to submitting the revised application, it is their intention to write once more to residents updating residents on the proposal.
